**Dear Excellencies,
All Indonesian People and the Government of the Republic of Indonesia,
Greetings of Peace, Unitary, and Synergy**

In connection with the end of the Democratic Party held in Indonesia, because it is related to security stability and world peace, then with this:

Therefore SPIA is closely observing the extent to which the Indonesian Government has implemented the four principles, in this case, addressed directly to the Executive, Legislative, Judiciary, Military, National Police and all Indonesian people. Have you applied these four principles, so as to create peace, harmony, security, and peace?

The existence of the Government and the people is one of the absolute requirements to become a state that is legitimately recognized by the United Nations. and must carry out the Universal Declaration on the Rights of Human Rights. The government must pay attention to people's rights, as well as the people must respect the government as the organizer of the government so that the nation and the state of Indonesia become a sovereign country, dignified and respected by the State in the whole world.

According to the 1945 Constitution (UUD 45), Chapter I Forms and Sovereignty Article 1. (1) The State of Indonesia is a unitary State in the form of a Republic, (2) Sovereignty is in the hands of the people and implemented according to the Constitution (3) law. Then Chapter III Power of State Government Article 4 (1) The President of the Republic of Indonesia holds the power of government according to the Constitution.

Based on the aforementioned 1945 Constitution, that in fact the People have Absolute Sovereignty and the Government has absolute Power. This means that both parties each have full authority to carry out their responsibilities, rights, and obligations. Therefore both parties must respect and respect each other, because both of them need each other, support each other and unite, so that they are not easily interfered

The peace expected by all countries in the world is as a reason for being formed by the United Nations on October 24th, 1945 in San Francisco, California, the United States by world leaders from the Founding Countries, namely Russia, America, China, France, and the United Kingdom. prevent the occurrence of wars or prevent conflicts between countries, create world peace and regulate world countries to be able to organize the wheels of government with stability and automatically create global stability in all aspects of human life on planet earth.

The Indonesian state officially became a member of the 60th United Nations on September 28th, 1950, which was determined by the UN General Assembly Resolution number A / RES / 491 (V) concerning "acceptance of the Republic of Indonesia in membership at the United Nations", less than one year after the recognition of Indonesian sovereignty by the Netherlands in the Round Table Conference in The Hague (August 23rd - November 2nd, 1949).

Consequently, the State of Indonesia as a legitimate United Nations State, it is obligatory to apply the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which contains 30 Articles and agreed upon by the General Assembly on December 10th, 1948.

One of the contents of the Universal Declaration is: Human rights are inherent rights of all humans, regardless of race, gender, nationality, ethnicity, language, religion, or another status.

Human rights include the right to life and freedom, freedom from slavery and torture, freedom of opinion and expression, the right to work and education, and more.

Everyone has the right to these rights, without discrimination from anyone and they are legally protected for their freedom in a country. After the historic declaration was issued, each country was obliged to implement human rights in their respective countries.

Every country has a different history and system of government. Similarly, Indonesia is not the same as Malaysia, Singapore and even the Superpower Country in the other hemisphere. Indonesia is one of the largest countries in several respects, namely the number of islands, population, number of tribes, number of languages, number of kingdoms and the largest in the world, even Indonesia's natural wealth is abundant, especially the natural wealth of gold mining as a capital base in building the nation and The Unitary State of the Republic of Indonesia.

Since the first Indonesian President, Sukarno, who is respected in the world, it is not without reason for the countries of the world to respect and dislike him. Because He has been given the mandate and capital to lead Indonesia and even the world by The King of Pakubuwono X, which was approved by the entire archipelago as a King who has full authority to regulate and lead the future of the archipelago's kingdom.


